

**LIST OF ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS 2017
FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS STUDYING AT THEIR OWN EXPENSE
(Screenings in November 2016, for entering in April 2017)**

1. Departments and the Number of Students Accepted

The Faculty of Engineering consists of ten departments:

- Department of Architecture
- Department of Urban Environment Systems
- Department of Design Science
- Department of Mechanical Engineering
- Department of Medical System Engineering
- Department of Electrical and Electronics Engineering
- Department of Nanoscience
- Department of Applied Chemistry and Biotechnology
- Department of Image Sciences
- Department of Informatics and Imaging Systems.

A few students are accepted to each of the departments.

2. Required Qualifications

Applicants must be non-Japanese nationals and fulfill all the requirements described in A, B and C. (Applicants are exempt from the National Center Test for University Admissions)

A. Applicants' visa status must allow for admission to university under the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act (Excluding applicants with permanent residency in Japan)

B. Applicants must fall under one of the following:

(a) Applicants must have completed or be scheduled to complete a standard 12-year education curriculum in an overseas education system by March 2017, or fulfill the equivalent requirements and are designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology.

(Note) "Requirements designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology" are as follows:

1) Applicants must have passed qualification examinations recognized by the home country which proves academic ability to be equivalent to individuals who have completed a standard 12-year education curriculum in an overseas education system (including examination based on national screening), and must be at least 18 years of age by March 2017.

2) Applicants must have completed an academic program equivalent to a high school education curriculum (including individuals who have passed qualification examinations recognized by the home country which proves academic ability to be equivalent to individuals who have completed the academic program (including examination based on national screening)), and have completed the preparatory curriculum for admission to

universities in Japan as stipulated separately by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, and must be at least 18 years of age by March 2017.

3) Applicants must have completed or be scheduled to complete an academic program by March 2017 which is equivalent to a high school education curriculum and is designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (the academic program shall be limited to the case: individuals who have passed the program must have completed a standard over-11-year education curriculum in the home country's education system, and which satisfies the standards as stipulated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology).

(b) Applicants hold a Baccalaureate diploma awarded by the International Baccalaureate Office, a judicial foundation based on Swiss Civil Code, and must be at least 18 years of age by March 2017.

(c) Applicants hold an Abitur Certificate recognized as university entrance qualification in the Federal Republic of Germany, and must be at least 18 years of age by March 2017.

(d) Applicants hold a Baccalaureate diploma recognized as university entrance qualification in the French Republic, and must be at least 18 years of age by March 2017.

(e) Applicants hold a General Certificate of Education Advanced Level diploma recognized as university entrance qualification in the United Kingdom of Great Britain and the Northern Ireland, and must be at least 18 years of age by March 2017.

(f) Applicants must be recognized as possessing academic capacity equivalent to a high school graduate through entrance qualification screening by Chiba University, and must be at least 18 years of age by March 2017.

C. Applicants who have taken the 2016 Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (Given in June) by Japan Student Services Organization for the subjects listed below:

For applicants to all the Departments, Faculty of Engineering, the total score of the designated subjects must be **80% or above**.

Department	Subjects
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Architecture• Urban Environment Systems• Design Science	Japanese as a Foreign Language, Mathematics Course 2, and two Science subjects (Physics/Chemistry/Biology). May take the exams in Japanese or English.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Mechanical Engineering• Medical System Engineering• Electrical and Electronics Engineering• Nanoscience• Informatics and Imaging Systems	Japanese as a Foreign Language, Mathematics Course 2, Physics, and either Chemistry or Biology. May take the exams in Japanese or English.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Applied Chemistry and Biotechnology• Image Sciences	Japanese as a Foreign Language, Mathematics Course 2, Physics and Chemistry. Exams must be taken in Japanese.

3. Application Forms

As for application, please submit the forms, which are included in the application guidebook. The

guidebook is available at the Administration Group for Student Affairs, Faculty of Engineering. **The details of the applicant screening is written in the guidebook in Japanese.** The application forms must be filled-in in Japanese. Applicants will be screened based on results from the 2016 Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students, the oral academic review test, and applicants' transcripts.
